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
1 About This Guide

This guide is intended for MediaPad T2 Pro running EMUI 4.0.

2 Getting Started

Installing USIM Card/microSD Card



- 1 Open Card Slot Cover
- 2 Insert USIM Card or microSD Card gently (metal contact up) until it clicks in place
- 3 Close Cover

Initial settings

Make initial settings for Wi-Fi, a Google account, and other options when powering on tablet for the first time. Follow onscreen prompts.

Install USIM Card before powering on tablet.

- 1 Make language and region settings
- 2 Configure Wi-Fi network to connect to as necessary
- 3 Follow onscreen prompts
- If already using another Android device, Tap "Copy your Google Accounts, apps, and data from your other device" to copy settings to tablet.

Google Account

If you already have a Google account, then in the screen for adding an account enter the Gmail email address. Follow onscreen prompts.

Locking and unlocking the screen

Locking the screen

If tablet has been idle for a certain period of time, screen locks itself automatically.
 Alternatively, press Power Key to lock the screen.

Note

In Home Screen, Tap Settings → Display → Sleep and select a time.

Unlocking the screen

• Press Power Key to wake tablet. Slide finger toward any direction to unlock screen.

Home Screen operations

- Tap application icons in Home Screen to open applications.
- Flick left/right in Home Screen to change pages.
- To customize Home Screen, Touch & Hold open area of Home Screen for options menu.
 Select customization for Wallpaper, widgets, etc.



Drag Status Bar down for Notifications Window. Tap Notifications/Shortcuts to toggle
 Notifications Window and Shortcuts Window.



- 1 Tap notification to view details. Flick left/right across notification to dismiss.
- 2 Tap iii to delete all notifications.
- Tap shortcut switches in Notifications Window to turn on or off functions.
 Touch & Hold switch for settings screen of corresponding function. Tap Edit to customize list.
- Orag slider to adjust screen brightness.
 Enable/disable automatic brightness.

Dual window gestures

Split the screen into two parts and view different content simultaneously.

To enable dual windows mode, Touch & Hold $\ \Box$ or use two fingers to slide up from bottom of screen.





On the screen, Drag beto adjust the screen ratio.

USIM Card

USIM Card is an IC card containing customer phone number and other information.

Handling USIM Card

- See instructions included with USIM Card for handling.
- Avoid applying labels. May damage USIM Card.
- USIM Card is replaceable (at cost) in case of loss/damage.
- Wipe clean with a dry, soft cloth.
- Always keep the IC chip (metal) clean.
- Always follow emergency procedures to suspend service if your USIM Card or table (USIM Card inserted) is lost/stolen. For details, contact Customer Service.
- Customer is responsible for any damage caused by inserting USIM Card in an otherbrand IC card reader, etc. SoftBank Corp. is not responsible in such case.
- It is recommended that you keep a separate copy of information that is stored on USIM
 Card. SoftBank Corp. is not responsible for damages from stored information that is lost.
- Always power off tablet before inserting/removing USIM Card.

- Note that USIM Card specifications and performance may change without notice.
- Return USIM Card to SoftBank Corp. when cancelling subscription.
- USIM Card is the property of SoftBank Corp.
- Returned USIM Cards are recycled for environmental purposes.

SIM-unlocking tablet

Tablet can be SIM-unlocked. SIM-unlocking tablet allows other-carrier SIM cards to be used with it.

- Some services, functions, etc. may have restrictions when an other-carrier SIM card is used. SoftBank Corp. does not guarantee operation whatsoever.
- For details on SIM unlocking, see SoftBank Website.

Center Access Code

Center Access Code is the four-digit code set at time of subscription, and is required such as when using option services from a landline phone.

- Do not forget Center Access Code. If you forget the code, contact us for recovery. For details, contact Customer Service.
- Be careful not to reveal security codes to others. If misused by others, SoftBank Corp. is not liable for any resulting damages.

USIM PIN

USIM PIN and locking USIM Card

By locking USIM Card, entry of USIM PIN (code for using USIM Card) to use tablet is required when powering on tablet. This effectively prohibits unauthorized use by others.

- USIM Card becomes locked by enabling USIM PIN.
- At time of purchasing USIM Card, USIM PIN is set to "9999" (and can be changed).

Note

- USIM PIN entry will be required when working with the USIM PIN or powering on tablet and USIM Card is locked.
- Entering incorrect USIM PIN three consecutive times activates PIN Lock. To cancel,
 Personal Unblocking Key (PUK) is required; contact Customer Service.
- Entering incorrect PUK ten consecutive times locks USIM Card, disabling tablet. For recovery, USIM Card must be reissued at a SoftBank Shop (fees apply).

Enabling USIM PIN

When USIM PIN is enabled, a window for entering USIM PIN (code for using USIM Card) appears to allow tablet use each time tablet is powered on with USIM Card installed.

- 1 In Home Screen, Settings → Advanced settings → Security
- $2 \quad \text{Set up SIM card lock} \rightarrow \text{Lock SIM card}$
- 3 Enter USIM PIN → OK ()
 - USIM PIN is enabled and USIM Card is locked.

Unlocking USIM Card

 $\textbf{1} \quad \text{In SIM card lock settings window, Lock SIM card} \rightarrow \textbf{Enter USIM PIN} \rightarrow \textbf{OK} \, (\bigcirc \hspace{-0.5em})$

Operation when powering on tablet

When powering on tablet and USIM Card is locked, window appears for entering USIM PIN. To use tablet:

- 1 Enter USIM PIN →
 - Tablet can be used.

Changing USIM PIN

 \bullet First lock USIM Card to change USIM PIN. For details, see "Enabling USIM PIN" (\to P.

13).

- $\textbf{1} \quad \text{In Home Screen, Settings} \rightarrow \text{Advanced settings}$
- $\begin{tabular}{lll} \bf 2 & Set \ up \ SIM \ card \ lock \rightarrow Change \ SIM \ PIN \rightarrow Enter \ current \ USIM \ PIN \rightarrow OK \rightarrow \\ & Enter \ new \ USIM \ PIN \rightarrow OK \rightarrow Enter \ new \ USIM \ PIN \ again \rightarrow OK \\ \end{tabular}$
 - · USIM PIN is changed.

3 Text Entry

Tablet comes with multiple input methods. Quickly enter text using the onscreen keyboard.

- Tap a text input field for onscreen keyboard.
- When done, Tap
 ✓ to hide onscreen keyboard.

Editing text

Copy, cut, and paste text.

Select text

Touch & Hold the text field until and appear. Drag and to select the text to edit, or Tap Select all to select all text.

Copy text

After selecting text, Tap Copy.

Cut text

After selecting text, Tap Cut.

Paste text

Tap where to insert text (to move insertion point, Drag •) and Tap Paste to paste the copied or cut text.

Selecting an input method

Tablet provides multiple ways to text input. Select preferred input method.

- 1 On text editing screen, Tap text field
 - · Onscreen keyboard appears.
- 2 Flick Notification Bar down
 - · Notifications Window opens.
- 3 In Notifications Window, Select input method
- 4 Select input method

4 Network Connection

Connecting to a Wi-Fi network

Select from detected Wi-Fi networks.

- 1 In Home Screen, Settings → Wi-Fi → Wi-Fi ()
 - · Wi-Fi is enabled.
 - · Tap Wi-Fi again to disable Wi-Fi ().
- $2 \quad \text{Tap access point} \rightarrow \text{Enter password} \rightarrow \text{Connect}$
 - Tablet is connected.
 - · Password (indicated by WEP, WPA, KEY, etc.) may be found on a label on your Wi-Fi router. For details, contact the vendor of the router. For public wireless LAN services, inquire about the password with your ISP.
 - · Omit password entry for unprotected access points.

Note

- To connect to a Wi-Fi network that uses a hidden SSID, Tap Add network → Enter required network information (SSID etc.) to connect.
- Enabling Wi-Fi increases power consumption. To save battery power, disable Wi-Fi when not in use.

Connecting to a Wi-Fi network (WPS)

If your wireless router supports WPS (Wi-Fi Protected Setup), use WPS to quickly connect to a Wi-Fi network

- 1 In Home Screen, Settings → Wi-Fi → Wi-Fi ()
 - · Wi-Fi is enabled.
 - · Tap Wi-Fi again to disable Wi-Fi ().

- $\begin{tabular}{ll} \bf 2 & {\sf Menu} \to {\sf Advanced settings} \to {\sf WPS connection/WPS PIN connection} \to {\sf Follow} \\ & {\sf onscreen prompts} \\ \end{tabular}$
 - · Tablet is connected.

 Enabling Wi-Fi increases power consumption. To save battery power, disable Wi-Fi when not in use.

A google account is required to download applications.

 - · Application is installed.

Note

 Some applications are incompatible with tablet, and will not operate correctly or can damage tablet's system. Only download applications from trusted sources.

Adding contacts

Use the Contacts application to manage contacts information including names, phone numbers, and email addresses.

- 1 In Home Screen, Tools → Contacts
 - · Contacts opens.
 - · If no contacts are saved, "No contacts" appears.

2 New contact

- · If confirmation appears, follow onscreen prompts.
- · If no contacts are saved, Tap "Create a new contact."

3 Enter required items

- Tap to delete a selected item's entry field.
- · Tap V in Name field to enter a name prefix, middle name, etc.
- · Tap Mobile or Home for entry fields to select labels (categories).
- · Tap Add another field to add an address, birthday, etc.

Syncing contacts

Sync contacts saved to a Gmail or Exchange account with tablet.

- 1 In Home Screen, Settings → Accounts
- $\begin{tabular}{ll} \bf 2 & Tap\ account\ type\ in\ Accounts\ field \rightarrow Tap\ account\ to\ sync \\ \end{tabular}$
- 3 Sync People details ()
 - · Sync settings are made.

Note

• If no account is listed for syncing with tablet, Tap Add account and add an account.

Accounts are synced automatically once the account is added.

Importing contacts

Import contacts from microSD Card.

- 1 In Home Screen, Tools → Contacts
 - · Contacts opens.
- 2 Menu \rightarrow Import/Export \rightarrow Select where to import to \rightarrow Follow onscreen prompts
 - · Contacts are imported.

Backing up contacts

Back up contacts to internal storage or microSD Card as a precaution to contacts being accidently erased or lost.

- 1 In Home Screen, Tools → Contacts
 - · Contacts opens.
- 2 Menu → Import/Export → Select where to export to → Export → Tap contacts → OK
 - · Contacts are exported.

Sharing contacts

Use email and Bluetooth® to share contacts saved in tablet.

- 1 In Home Screen, Tools → Contacts
 - · Contacts opens.
- 2 Tap contact to share → Menu → Share contact → Tap application → Follow onscreen prompts
 - · Contact is sent.

Thread list/folder list

View mail in thread list or folder list.

Thread list is described in the User Guide.

Switching between thread list and folder list

- 1 In Home Screen, Mail
- 2 Tap name of current list view (Thread list/Folder list) → Tap name of list view to change to
 - List view switches.

Thread list

Sent and received S! Mail/SMS is displayed sorted by recipient. When viewing messages exchanged with Yamamoto-san, messages are displayed as a conversation with Yamamoto-san within a single thread.



- Thread with mailing contact
- 2 Message text entry field

- 3 Exchanged message content
- 4 Send S! Mail/SMS

Folder list

Messages are sorted and saved in folders such as Inbox and Sent Box.

Sending S! Mail/SMS

- Note
- When \triangleleft is Tapped while creating S! Mail or SMS, the message is saved as a draft.
- Drafts are saved to Draft Box in folder list, and are indicated as

 ø in thread list. Open an
 S! Mail/SMS draft to edit and send it.

Sending S! Mail/SMS

- 1 In Home Screen, Mail →
- 2
 - · Alternatively, enter phone numbers or email addresses in To field directly.
- 3 Phonebook, Outgoing History, Incoming History, or Mail Group → Select recipients → OK
 - · Tap Phonebook, Outgoing History, or Incoming History to select recipients from Phonebook, Outgoing History, or Incoming History.
 - \cdot $\;$ Tap Mail Group to select a mail group and set all the members on the list as recipients.
 - · After setting recipients, Tap ooo to check recipients' phone numbers/email addresses or set them to Cc/Bcc.
 - · Message is sent as S! Mail when recipients in Cc/Bcc are specified.
 - To delete a recipient, Tap ooo and then X.
- 4 Tap Subject/Compose email fields → Enter subject/text

- · Message is sent as S! Mail when a subject is entered or file is attached.

5 Send

- S! Mail/SMS is sent.
- · Failed S! Mail/SMS messages are saved as drafts.

Sending decore mail by S! Mail

Using a template

Choose from a variety of designs to decorate mail.

- 2 SELECT
- $\textbf{3} \quad \text{Enter recipients} \rightarrow \text{Enter subject} \rightarrow \text{Enter text}$
- 4 Send
 - · Decore mail is sent.

Decorating S! Mail

- 1 While entering message text, +
 - · Message is ready to be decorated.
- 2 Tap decorating method → Follow onscreen prompts
 - · Decorate while entering message text.

Opening & replying to S! Mail/SMS

Tablet receives S! Mail/SMS messages automatically by default. Optionally, retrieve messages manually, and also retrieve all messages stored on the server.

Opening new S! Mail/SMS

When message arrives, new message notice and Notification Icon appear.

1 Tap notification

- · S! Mail/SMS message window opens.
- · To open new message from Notification Icon, Drag Notification Bar down for Notifications Window, then Tap corresponding notification.
- · For two or more new messages, thread list opens.

Note

- Set spam filtering to save messages from senders not in Contacts to spam mail thread.
 New mail notification does not appear. To check messages saved to spam mail thread:
- 1 In Home Screen, Mail \rightarrow \blacksquare \rightarrow Spam mail
 - · If confirmation appears, follow onscreen instructions.

Retrieving S! Mail/SMS manually

- 1 In Home Screen, Mail \rightarrow C
 - · Mail is received.

Retrieving server mail

- 1 In Home Screen, Mail \rightarrow \blacksquare \rightarrow Handle Server Mail
- 2 Receive whole content for all server mails or Receive subject and sender for all server mails
 - · Server mail is received.

Replying to S! Mail/SMS

- 1 In S! Mail/SMS message window,
 or
- 2 Enter text

3 Send

Message is sent.

Forwarding S! Mail/SMS

- 1 In S! Mail/SMS message window,
- $2 \quad \text{Enter recipients} \rightarrow \text{Enter text}$
- 3 Send
 - · Message is forwarded.

Managing S! Mail/SMS

Viewing S! Mail/SMS

- 1 In Home Screen, Mail
 - · Thread list opens.

2 Tap thread

- · Thread details open.
- · To view message drafts and unsent messages, Tap thread indicated with for the thread details with the draft/unsent S! Mail/SMS draft or message.

3 Tap message

· S! Mail/SMS message window opens.

Note

Add widgets to check message information in Home Screen. Widgets are available in
"easy mode" and "detailed mode" versions. Check number of unread messages with
easy mode widgets. Check date/time and preview of messages in addition to number of
unread messages with detailed mode widgets. Content of latest message appears if all
messages are read.

Checking available storage on mail server

Protecting messages

- 1 In thread details, Touch & Hold message to protect →Lock Message
 - · To unprotect message, Tap Lock Message again.

Saving attachments

1 In S! Mail/SMS message window, \square \rightarrow Select attachment \rightarrow Save

Deleting a thread in thread list

- 1 In thread list, Touch & Hold thread $\rightarrow \stackrel{\blacksquare}{\square} \rightarrow Delete$
 - · To select several threads, Touch & Hold first thread then Tap other threads.

Deleting a message in thread details

1 In thread details, Touch & Hold message → Delete





 - · Backup starts.


