

Free Mail for Family Discount and Designated Number Customers

Vodafone K.K. only operator to offer free mail for customers on a designated number discount

Vodafone K.K. today announces that starting 1 February it will change the mail discount rate for sending and receiving mails for customers signed up to Family Discount and Designated Number Discount.

Previously, Vodafone customers received a 50% discount when making voice and video calls or exchanging mails between others signed up to the Family Discount or Designated Number Discount plans. By making the sending and receiving of mails free of charge, customers who sign up in the future to these plans will be able to enjoy mail communications even more than before with family and friends, the main people they communicate with. For customers who are already signed up to Family Discount and Designated Number Discount, the previous 50% discount for exchanging mails will automatically be changed to 100% without any application requirements. These changes make Vodafone K.K. the first* operator in Japan to offer free mail exchanges for customers signed up to a designated number discount service.

Service Changes

- The discount for mail exchanges between customers signed up to Family Discount will change from 50% to 100%.
- The discount for mail exchanges between customers signed up to the Designated Number Discount will change from 50% to 100%.
 - *Changes are applicable to Sky Mail, Long Mail, SMS and MMS exchanged between family members or designated numbers using Vodafone K.K. phone numbers.
 - *Changes are applicable to mails sent and received in Japan.

Timing for Service Change

- Applicable starting 1 Feb 2005
 - *New discount rate will be effective for 1 Feb for customers with monthly bills closing at the end of the month, 11 Feb for customers with monthly bills closing on the 10th of every month, 21 Feb for customers with monthly bills closing on the 20th of every month.
 - *Changes will automatically apply to customers already signed up to Family Discount and Designated Number Discount without any application requirements.

Appendix

Family Discount

Family Discount requires no fixed monthly charge or registration cost and offers a 50% discount on basic charges and voice/video calls for up to 4 family members of the main subscriber. In addition, the sending to or receiving of mails from other family members will be free.

Designated Number Discount

With the Designated Number Discount, up to 5 numbers (5 Vodafone K.K. numbers, or 4 Vodafone K.K. numbers and 1 fixed line number) can be registered for a discount of 50% on voice/video calls for a monthly charge of 300 yen (315 yen with tax). In addition, <u>mails sent to or received from</u> registered designated numbers will be free.
