Vodafone K.K. announces today that on 1 September 2005 it launched a new Music Search service on its mobile internet service Vodafone live!, so customers can find Chaku-Uta[®], Chaku-Uta[®] Long Version, and Chaku-Uta Full[®] music tracks faster and with greater ease.

For the price of communication charges alone, the Music Search service lets customers search Chaku-Uta® and Chaku-Uta Full® music track content by artist name. After inputting the artist's name (even partially) in either *kanji*, *hiragana*, alphabetical letters or numbers, Vodafone live! official artist song content is searched according to a given keyword and links to artist information pages are displayed.

Artist information pages give a list of content sites that offer the artist's tracks so customers can quickly download*¹ the tracks they want, and obtain related information*² on live performances and upcoming events. Content is searched*³ according to the music tracks that can be downloaded by a customer's Vodafone K.K. handset*⁴.




