Vodafone K.K. to offer free international plug adapter rental service

Rentals available at 5 Vodafone counters in Narita, Kansai and Centrair airports

Vodafone K.K. announces today that from 20 December 2005 to 31 May 2006*1, it will offer free international plug adapter (converter) rentals at its 5 Vodafone counters in Narita International Airport (Terminal 1 and Terminal 2), Kansai International Airport (Departure and Arrival lobbies) and the Central Japan International Airport (Centrair).

The adapter supports 4 types of wall outlets—Europe, UK, USA and Australia—so customers can recharge their handsets in over 150 countries and regions.

Customers using international roaming compatible Vodafone K.K. 3G handsets^{*2} will be eligible for the service and can rent the adapters by filling out an application at one of the airport counters. One adapter is available per customer.

During the rental service period, at the Vodafone counters customers will receive questionnaires on their purpose for traveling and mobile handset usage abroad. Customers who return the questionnaire will be eligible to receive a Vodafone K.K. original luggage tag, which has information on how to make calls to Japan and change various settings of Vodafone K.K. 3G handsets while abroad.

Vodafone K.K. will continue to expand its lineup of roaming capable 3G handsets and its roaming footprint to offer richer communication to customers.
