Vodafone K.K. developing mobile business models

Handsets to support VoIP* calls made inside the office over internal wireless LANs

Vodafone K.K. today announces that it plans to offer two new mobile business models in autumn 2006. Both devices (manufactured by Nokia) will run on Vodafone K.K.'s 3G network and on wireless LANs.

Vodafone K.K. is moving ahead with the development of these business devices, which are based on the Nokia E60 and Nokia E61, models currently available for enterprise customers in Europe and Asia (see URLs below for photos). Both devices support wireless LAN connectivity for VoIP calls in the office over internal wireless LANs, and Vodafone K.K.'s 3G network for calls away from the workplace, to enable cost-effective and seamless communication, regardless of whether employees are inside or outside their offices.

Following Vodafone Mobile Office, which is based on a similar concept, this new offering of Vodafone K.K. 3G handsets with company wireless LAN connectivity will allow for seamless integration with existing company extension systems, and Vodafone K.K. will actively work with system integrators and other business partners to offer a selection of mobile centrex solution environments that are optimal for different usage patterns.
