## Vodafone K.K. further expands international roaming service areas

New addition brings total up to 160 countries and regions

Vodafone K.K. announces today that from 2 August 2006 it will expand international roaming service areas in which customers can use their Vodafone K.K. 3G handsets\*1 abroad. With this area expansion, roaming will be available to Vodafone K.K. customers traveling to Uzbekistan in Central Asia, enabling them to make voice calls in a total of 160 countries and regions. Additionally, a further 17 countries and regions will be added to support the Vodafone live! internet service, bringing the total to 84 countries and regions.

To further improve customer convenience, Vodafone K.K. is progressively increasing the number of roaming partners in countries and regions where roaming is available. As of 2 August, Vodafone K.K. will have tied up with multiple operators in 67 of the 160 supported countries and regions, allowing customers to roam on a total of 229 networks.
