# **Emergency Calls**

Call 110 (Police), 119 (Fire & Ambulance) or 118 (Japan Coast Guard) even when Call Barring is activated.

■ Situations Where Emergency Call is Available

Available	Key lock is activated     All outgoing calls are barred
Not available	SoftBank USIM Card not inserted     Key lock with Password     In PIN entry window     In PUK entry window

#### **■** Emergency Location Report

Your location is automatically reported to the corresponding agency such as police when you place an emergency call (110, 119 or 118) with SoftBank 3G handsets. This system is called "Emergency Location Report." The reported location is based on the positioning signals sent from base stations to handset.

- No application fees or connection fees apply.
- Reported location may be inaccurate, depending on the caller's location and signal strength. Make sure to provide your location, nearby landmarks and purpose on the phone.
- Emergency Location Report works with those agencies that have the system installed.
- Dial 184 before emergency numbers to not report your location.
   However, first responders may obtain your location information for situations where an immediate and serious threat to life is concerned.


# Voice Call

### **Making Calls**

- In Standby, enter a phone number including area code
  - Always enter area code even from within the same area code.

The call is made.

- To adjust volume:



"Call ended" and the call time appear for about two seconds. Then Display returns to Standby.



#### Correcting Misentries

to move the cursor to the right of the digit you want to delete, then Press (NEACE). Enter correct digits. Long Press (NEACE) to delete all the digits to the left of the cursor.

#### **International Calls**

Make voice calls from Japan to outside Japan.

- 1 ★ twice (+) + country code + phone number > 🎤 / 🌒 (Call)

- When making an international call from Incoming History without having changed the international code setting, the set international code is automatically added to the number.

# **Answering Calls**

Ringtone sounds for an incoming call.

The caller's phone number or name saved in Phone Book appears if Caller ID is sent.

- If not, "Withheld call" appears.
- (Accept) > Talk to the caller
  - To adjust volume: 🔘
- 2 After the call ends > ¬¬••

  "Call ended" and the call time appear for about two seconds.



### **Handling Incoming Calls**

Handle an incoming call as follows:

Mute ringtone*	(CLEAR ), (O & - 9 % YZ, ***, #**
Hold call	(Options) > Hold
Answering Machine	(Options) > Answering machine
Reject call	(Reject)

- \*Receive incoming calls when Any key answer is On.
  - Mute setting is deactivated after the call.

Security code set at initial subscription is required to activate this service (P.1-20).

The following items can be set:

Item	Description
Bar all outgoing calls	All outgoing calls cannot be placed
Bar outgoing calls (international)	International calls cannot be placed
Bar all incoming calls	All incoming calls cannot be accepted
Cancel all call barring	Deactivate all outgoing and incoming call barring  Enter security code set at initial subscription
Reject numbers	Reject calls by specifying individual phone numbers in Specified numbers or by specifying caller types. Caller types you can specify to reject are Not saved numbers, Payphone, Withheld call, and Unsaved numbers (phone numbers not saved in Phone Book)

### **Activating/Deactivating Call Barring**

- 1 Bar all outgoing calls/Bar outgoing calls (international)/Bar all incoming calls > Activate/Deactivate

  - A message indicating that Call Barring is activated appears when you attempt to place a call. It may take time to show the message depending on the region you are in. If no message appears, check Call Barring settings.

#### **Checking Call Barring Settings**

Bar all outgoing calls/Bar outgoing calls (international)/Bar all incoming calls > Check status

#### **Deactivating All Call Barring**

#### Caller ID

Default is the setting (Set by network) which was specified at initial subscription.
