# Basics

#### Send messages via S! Mail, SMS or PC Mail.

- SoftBank Mobile messaging services are available in Japan and overseas.

## **Messaging Folders**



\* Set Auto-sort messages to specified folders automatically ( $\square P.4-6$ ).

#### **Operations while Using PC Mail**

Setting PC Mail accounts creates account folders in Messaging Folders. S! Mail/SMS operations may change as a result.

#### Auto Resend

Handset saves unsendable messages (out-of-range, Offline Mode) to Unsent folder and automatically sends when able. Messages are protected until sent.

- To selectively cancel Auto Resend: → Select a folder → Highlight a message → ()[Menu] → Release Resending
- Unsendable messages created while Auto Resend is set to OFF are not automatically resent. Those already saved before Auto Resend is set to OFF are automatically resent. To cancel Auto Resend function,

#### **Deleting Messages Automatically**

When Messaging Folders are full, old messages are automatically deleted one by one. Protect important messages or set deletion setting to *OFF*. Messages in Drafts and SMS on USIM Card are not deleted automatically.

- To protect messages: In message list, select/highlight a message →
   ∑[Menu] → Protect → This one or Selected (→ For Selected, check messages → [□][Finish])
- To cancel Auto Delete: 
  → Settings → Universal Settings → Auto Delete → Auto Sent Msg Del or Auto Received Msg Del → OFF
- View Memory Status
- > 🖂 → Memory Status

# **Receiving Messages**

#### **Retrieving S! Mail Automatically**

Auto download retrieves messages. Transmission fees are incurred; adjust as required.

ullet To cancel auto download/limit message size for auto download: 🗇 Right

# When a new message is received, 🛛 appears and Information Window opens in Standby.

## **Retrieving Complete S! Mail**

When Center sends initial portion of message (S! Mail Notice), retrieve the complete message manually.

#### Edit Sort Conditions

#### Delete Auto-sort Settings

#### Re-sort Set Folders

> To re-sort messages in a specific folder: After Step 1, highlight a folder ightarrow

 $\mathbf{Y}$ [Menu]  $\rightarrow Re\text{-sort in This} \rightarrow YES$ 

> To re-sort messages in all folders: After Step 1, [Y][Menu] -> Sort in All -> YES

## PC Mail

 Auto Check settings may incur high packet transmission fees. Be careful, especially when using handset abroad. (To disable Auto Check: P.4-7)

## PC Mail Account Setup

- Check ISP information in advance.
- PC Mail services may not be available depending on services, settings, contract details for PC mail account.
