

Getting Started

Capture photos or record video.

Various Sizes

Select small sizes to send captured photos/recorded video using S! Mail[®]; select larger sizes for higher resolutions.

Auto Focus

Measures the distance between subjects and Camera to adjust focus.

Shooting Modes

Apply effect or add frame, or capture successive photos.

Review

Open/play last saved Camera file quickly; access older files as needed.

*May not be delivered as sent depending on shooting size or recipient device.

Important Camera Usage Notes

- Clean dust/smudges from Lens Cover with soft dry cloth before use.
- Camera is a precision instrument; however, some pixels may remain on/off.
- Shooting/saving images while handset is hot may affect the image quality.
- Exposing Lens to direct sunlight may damage Color Filter and affect image color.

Automatic Shutdown

- Camera shuts down after a period of inactivity and handset returns to Standby.

Shutter Click

- Shutter click and Self-timer tone sound at fixed volume regardless of handset settings.

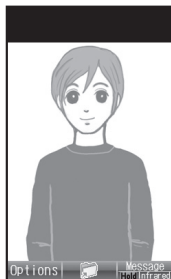

(To start over, press .)







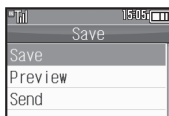

Incoming Calls while Recording

- Recorded clip remains even if the call is answered. End the call to save it, etc.

If Battery Runs Low

- Recording stops. (Recorded clip is saved.)

Open/play last saved Camera file; access older files as needed.

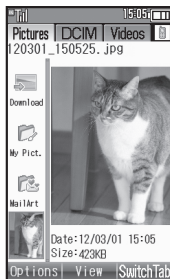

Using Shooting Modes

May be unavailable depending on selected shooting size.

Self-timer

- In Photo/Video Viewfinder,**
 ➔ **Self-timer** ➔ 
- Select time** ➔ 
- Frame subject on Display**
 ➔ 
 - After selected time elapses, photo is captured or recording starts.
 - To stop recording, press .
 - For more, see operation descriptions on P.7-2 or P.7-3.

Releasing Shutter during Countdown
 After ,

Incoming Calls/Alarm during Countdown
 • Countdown stops. (Self-timer remains active.)

Continuous Shoot (Photo Camera)






Available modes:

4 Pictures	Capture four separate photos with index image
9 Pictures	Capture nine separate photos with index image
Overlapped	Capture five photos to create a composite image

- In Photo Viewfinder,**  ➔ **Modes** ➔ 



Mode Menu

- Continuous Shoot** ➔ 
- Select mode** ➔  ➔ **Select speed** ➔ 
- Frame subject on Display**
 ➔ 
 - After shooting, index image or a composite image appears.
 - When shooting speed is set to **Manual** (4 Pictures and 9 Pictures modes), repeat  for each shot.










- (Long Press)**

- All captured photos are saved.

 - Press  to save photo. (Viewfinder returns.)
