Important TV Usage Notes

Recording Timer Precautions

Confirm target channel reception; keep handset open.

- Insert a Memory Card.
- Exit all active functions/applications.
- Confirm Battery charge and memory status.

At Timer Time (TV Alarm Time)

TV and Alarm activate.



Signal reception starts slightly before the Timer start time and program recording/ viewing ends a few seconds after the Timer end time.

While Using Another Function

 TV activates (Multi Job) and target program recording/viewing starts. If Multi Job cannot activate in the current state, TV may remain off, or the current function may exit automatically (unsaved images, messages, contacts, etc. may be deleted).
