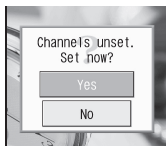


Area Setup

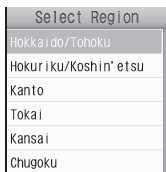
When activating TV for the first time, set up channels by area. (TV is exclusively for use in Japan.)



TV Antenna

TV Antenna is located behind Display. Check signal strength indicator and move handset to find best reception. (More bars indicate stronger signal.)

Signal Strength Indicator

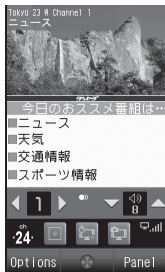

2 Use Dialpad to select channel

- Use  to surf channels in list order; Long Press to find channel with stable signal automatically.

Incoming Calls

- Press  to answer calls.

When Answering Voice Calls with Memory Card Inserted

- Current program is temporarily recorded; start playback after the call. (Time Shift)

Incoming Messages

- Tone sounds and notice appears. Long Press  to access messages.

Important TV Usage Notes

- Do not use TV while driving or cycling. Accidents may result. Phone use while driving is prohibited by the Road Traffic Law (revised November 1, 2004). When walking, always pay attention to your surroundings, especially near road/rail crossings, etc.
- When using TV while charging Battery, separate AC Charger cord and TV Antenna to avoid interference.
- Call transmissions, incoming messages or mobile phone use in the immediate vicinity may affect audiovisual quality.
- Programs may not be viewable or record properly when:
 - Too far from or too close to broadcasting stations
 - In mountainous areas or near tall buildings
 - Aboard trains or in moving vehicles
 - Near high-voltage lines, neon lights or wireless base stations
 - Near railroad tracks or highways
 - Anywhere interfering signals are broadcast/reception is unstable

Widescreen

While watching TV or playing recorded programs, rotate handset 90 degrees; TV orientation changes accordingly.

Multi Selector

Multi Selector functions change with TV orientation.

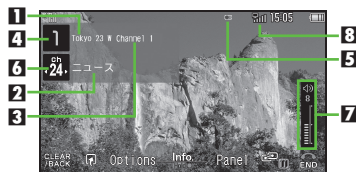

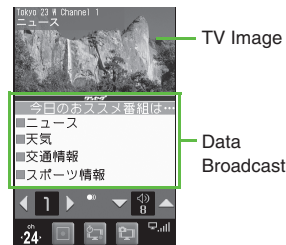

Data Broadcast (Japanese)

In portrait view, Data Broadcast appears below TV image. Use to select an item and Press to access program-related information and interactive services.



Data Broadcast Window

Data Broadcast Fees

- Data Broadcast information viewing is free; however, using data links/related services incurs Internet connection fees.
- Confirmation appears the first time a fee-based Network connection is established from a channel; if accepted, further Network connections are established without confirmation until the channel is changed.

Recording Programs

Recorded content is saved to handset (or Memory Card, if inserted).

Precautions

- Saved files cannot be forwarded or attached to messages.
- Handset encryption technology prevents unauthorized copying or playback of Memory Card files. Files copied from Memory Card to other cards on PC are unplayable.
- Copyright laws limit duplicated material to private use only, and prohibit unauthorized reproduction/other use.
- SoftBank Mobile Corp. is not liable for any damages resulting from accidental loss or alteration of recorded content.

Dubbing 10

- Handset supports Dubbing 10 copy protection scheme that allows recordings to be copied from handset to Memory Card. Open file properties for remaining copy count.





- Changing Volume, etc. does not affect recordings.
- When Notification Lamp flashes, reception is poor; change location to where Notification Lamp illuminates green (moderate) or blue (strong).

2 (Long Press) ➔ Recording ends

Using Touchscreen

- Tap  to start recording. To stop, Tap .
 - In landscape view, Touch & Hold **Hold** . (To stop, Touch & Hold **Hold** .)

Chase Play (Playing while Recording)

- Watch a program from the beginning while recording it on Memory Card.
 - [Recording Window]  ➔ **Rec./TimeShift** ➔  ➔ **Time Shift Play** ➔  ➔ **Playback starts** ➔  (Long Press) ➔ **Playback stops**
 - To start playback using Touchscreen, Tap **Options** ➔ **Rec./**  ➔  **Play**. To stop, Touch & Hold **Hold** .

Memory/Battery Runs Low or Video Call is Accepted

- Recording stops. (Recorded content is saved.)

Saving Files from the Internet while Recording

- While recording programs to handset, confirm memory status before saving files.

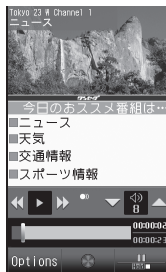

Playback Window

- Playback starts. (The last played file plays from where it stopped.)

Switching Video Lists

After 1, [TV] ➔ *Change to Phone or Change to MemoryCard* ➔ [Play]

Main Playback Operations

Adjust Volume or change Display size following the same operations used while watching TV.

Rewind	Drag left across TV image ¹ .
Fast Forward	Drag right across TV image ¹ .
Pause	Tap Pause [TV].
Stop Playback	Touch & Hold Hold [TV].
Skip to Any Point	Drag slider.
Toggle View	Tap TV image.
Change Display Size	Pinch/Spread across TV image ³ .
Change Data Broadcast View	Pinch/Spread across Data Broadcast area ³ .

¹Release to resume normal playback.

²In pause, Drag left/right across TV image to reverse/advance frame.

Recording Timer Precautions

Confirm target channel reception; keep handset open.

- End all active functions/applications.
- Confirm Battery charge and memory status.

At Timer Time (TV Alarm Time)

TV and Alarm activate.



Signal reception starts slightly before the Timer start time and program recording/viewing ends a few seconds after the Timer end time.

While Using Another Function

- TV activates (Multi Job) and target program recording/viewing starts. If Multi Job cannot activate in the current state, TV may remain off, or the current function may end automatically (unsaved images, messages, contacts, etc. may be deleted). End all active functions/applications before Timer time.

Media Player Basics

Use Media Player to play music/videos on handset.

- Download media files from the Internet, or transfer files from PCs or AQUOS Blu-ray Disc recorders.
- Transfer PC music files and save them on Memory Card.

Playback Precautions

- Media Player may not support some recording/playback formats. Files may not play depending on Memory Card status.
- Playback stops for incoming calls.
- If Battery is low, Media Player does not play. Playback stops if Battery runs low during playback.
- Turn down Volume if distortion is noticeable in Speaker sound.
- Handset plays media while it downloads (progressive download). Packet transmission fees apply even while playback is paused.

Compatibility

- Files transferred from PCs cannot be used as ringtones or System Sounds.

Saving Music Files from PCs

- Use software to convert music file format.
- For software usage and specifications, see the provider's website, etc.
- SoftBank Mobile Corp. does not guarantee compatibility with any software.
- USB Cable may be purchased separately.
- Install USB Cable driver beforehand. See **P.6-9** "Utility Software (Japanese)."

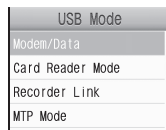
Handling Transferred Files

- Copyright laws limit duplicated material to private use only.
- Files created with PC software, etc. may not play.
- Comply with copyright and other intellectual property laws when using obtained files.

Saving WMA Files

Save WMA files using compatible software.

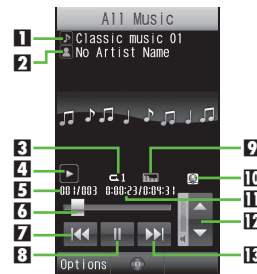

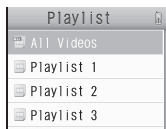

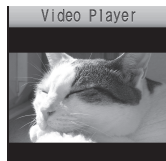

Skip Forward/Backward	[SKIP FWD] / [SKIP BWD]
Toggle View	[VIEW] (Interface On/Off) [ASPECT] (Display Size) [ASPECT] (Aspect)

Using Playlists

Playlists store music/videos in a playback order. Add favorite media files to Playlists, or organize files by artist/genre.

- Playlists store only file locations. Source files remain in All Music or All Videos.
- Music or Ring Songs-Tones subfolders containing music files appear in Playlists window; select a folder to play the files within it.

Icon View

Save icons of functions, files, folders, widgets, etc. to Icon View for easy access.

Saving Shortcuts to Icon View

- If selected page is full, remove icons first.
- Icons of installed widgets are saved automatically.



Icon View Page

- Press or to open next or previous page. (Press in **Page 1** to return to Standby.)

When Five or More Pages Exist

- Confirmation appears after 1. Choose **Yes** or **No** and Press .
- To disable confirmation thereafter, Press .
