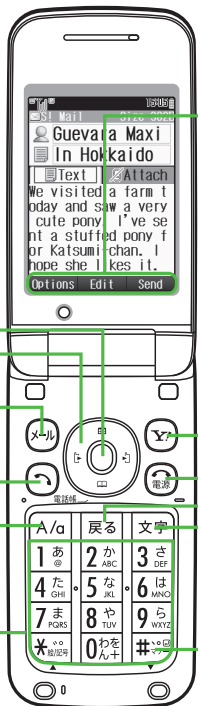

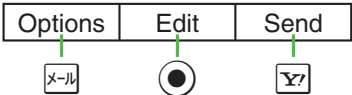

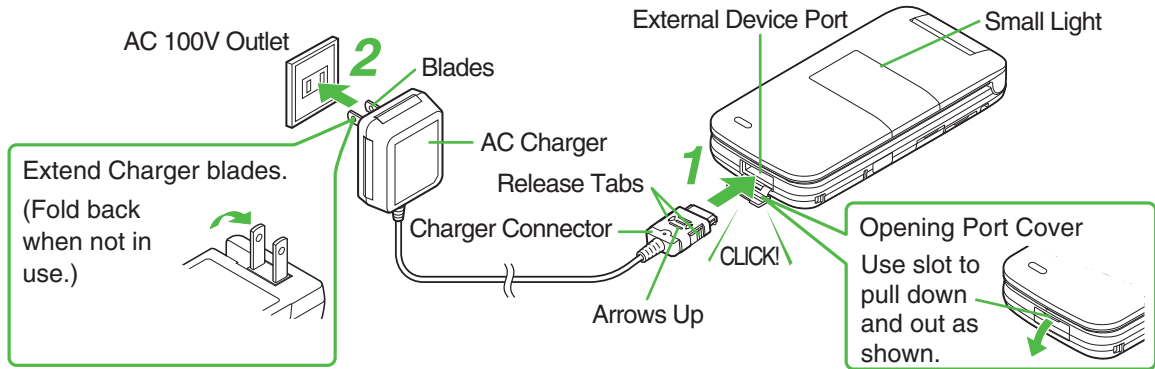

Charging



Use specified Charger only.

- 1 Open Port Cover to connect Charger**
- 2 Plug Charger into AC outlet**

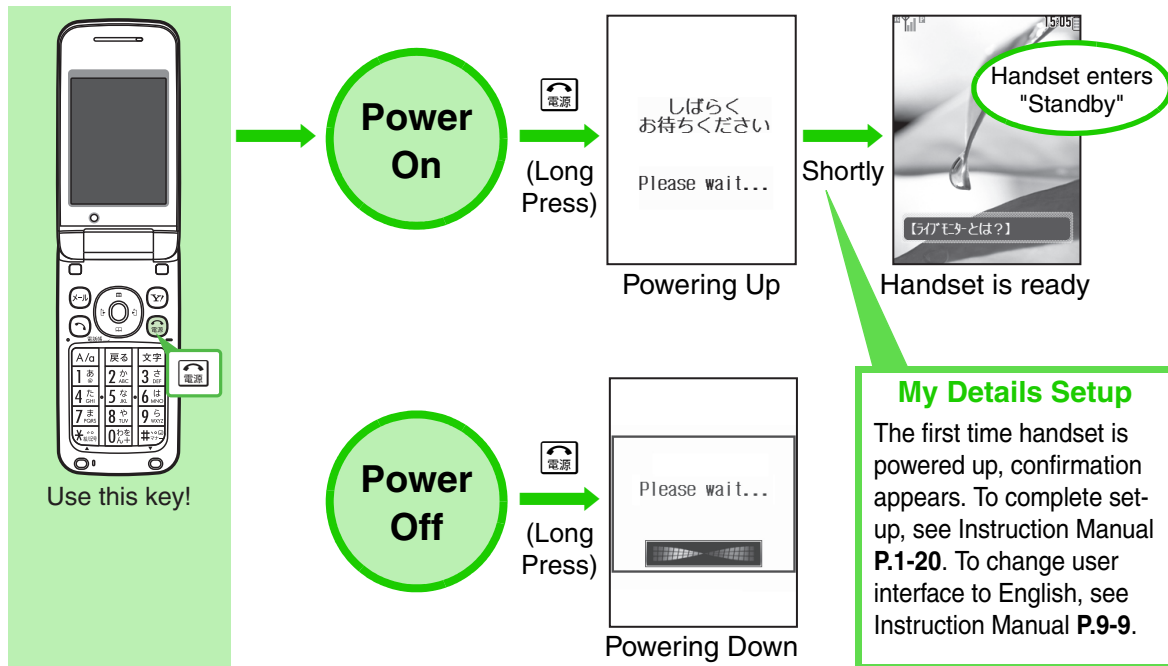
- Small Light illuminates red while charging; may take up to approximately 150 minutes.
- When charging completes Small Light goes out.

After Charging

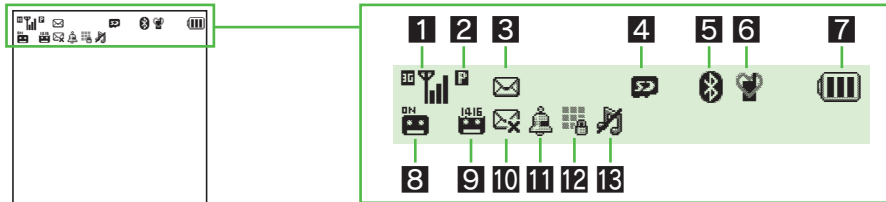
Unplug Charger, then disconnect handset

- Squeeze release tabs to remove connector.
- Replace Port Cover to protect External Device Port.

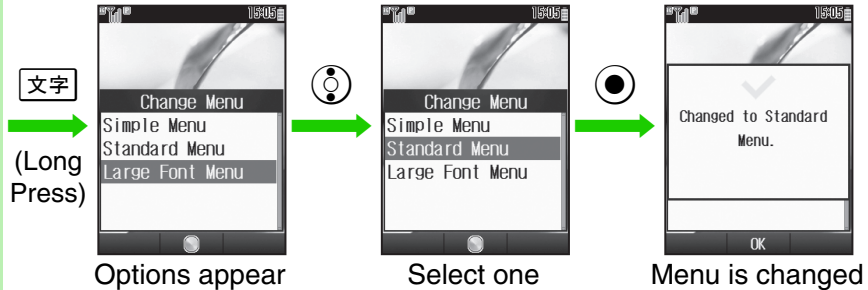
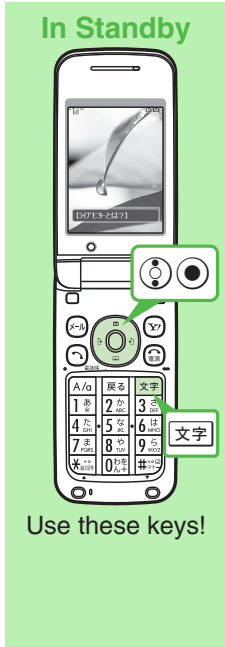
Add Email Address	Enter up to three addresses

Vib	Set vibration by caller/sender
Secret	Restrict access to Phone Book entries

Multiple characters are assigned to each key. Press a key to toggle between character options for that key.



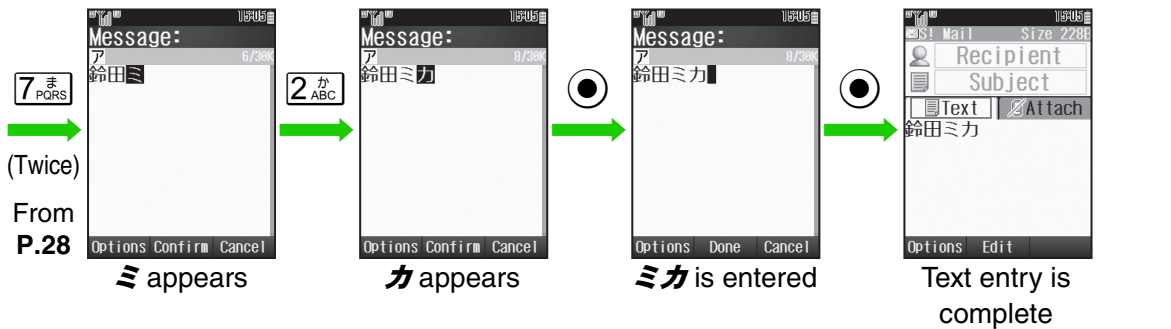
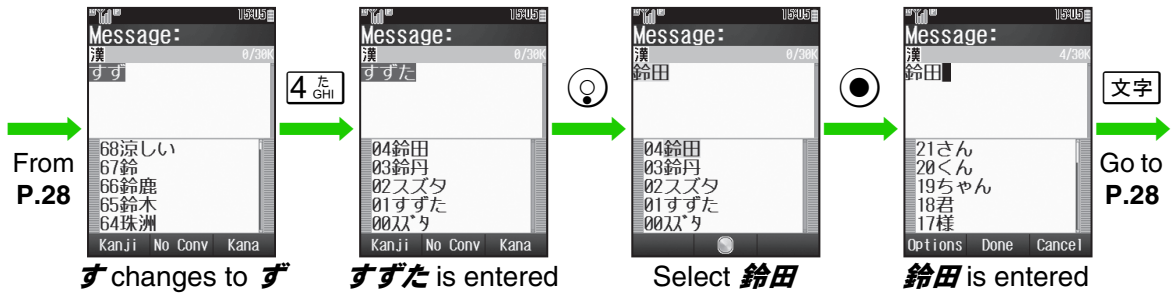
