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Text Entry

Enter alphanumerics, hiragana, kanji, katakana, symbols and pictographs.

Help

Help describes details of text entry operations. In text entry window, $\square[Menu] \rightarrow Help \rightarrow$ Select an item

Input Modes

- Press 📳 to toggle input modes.
- 漢 : Kanji (Hiragana)
- ከታ : Katakana
- abc: Alphanumerics
- 123: Numbers
- Alternatively, follow the steps below to toggle input modes.

[Menu] → Input Options → Change Input Mode

② Double-byte/Single-byte

Press and hold 📳 to toggle double-/single-byte.

- 1/1: Double-byte
- 1/2: Single-byte

Character/Byte Count

- Remaining number of enterable characters appears, regardless of input mode.
- Remaining number of enterable byte appears.



Entering Text

Entering Characters

Example: Enter 鈴木

- In alphanumerics mode, 📳 twice
 - to switch to kanji (hiragana) mode
 - す : ③ three times
 - ず: **○** * → ③ three times → ★
 - き: _2 twice
 - * When the next character is on the same key, press 🖸 first to move cursor.



🧕 to enter Forecast List

- To change word before converting, press
- There are four types of word suggestion list: Forecast, Normal, E-1-Kana and Prediction (CP P.3-5)

Other Input Functions

Enter katakana/ alphanumerics	Press I several times to select an input mode → Enter characters	
Enter small kana (つ , ッ , etc.)	Enter a character → to convert to small character ● Alternatively, press a key repeatedly to enter an assigned small kana.	
Enter upper case characters	 Enter a character → Alternatively, press a key repeatedly to enter an assigned upper case character. 	
Add [*] or [°]	 Enter a character to add ° or ° → ★ for ° or ★ twice for ° In single-byte katakana mode, ° and ° are entered as a single-byte character. 	
Insert line break	Press 🗖 to insert line breaks in text	
Insert space at end of text		
Insert space within text	Press # repeatedly until single-byte space appears*, or use symbol list for double-byte or single-byte space (fractional state).	
Toggle characters in reverse order	Example: From c, press \Box to toggle as follows. $c \rightarrow b \rightarrow a \rightarrow 2$	

* Space cannot be entered within text in number mode by following the steps above. Use symbol list.

Pictographs & Symbols

- Pictographs do not appear in messages sent to incompatible SoftBank handsets or e-mail.
- In kanji (hiragana) or alphanumerics mode, SoftBank pictograph list appears.
 - To toggle pictograph list and symbol list: 💌
- **7** Ito select a pictograph or symbol
 - Symbol List: 🕼 P.16-15

Note

- Alternatively, follow the steps to access pictograph or symbol: □[Menu] → *Pictograph* or *Symbol*
- List Log may appear first.

Entering Cross-carrier Pictographs

Press $\underline{\#}$ to toggle lists (Universal pictograph list, Full pictograph list and My Pictograms).

Emoticons

- > In text entry window, ☐[Menu] → *Emotions* → Select an emoticon
- Copy from Phone Book/Account Details/Notepad

Conversion Methods (Japanese)

Predictive Conversion

The following suggestion lists appear while entering text or after a word is fixed.

While	Forecast	Lists likely conversions (Predictive Candidates) and matching conversions (Normal Candidates) Predictive Candidates: わ → 私, わたし, etc. Normal Candidates: わ → 和, 輪, etc.
Text	Normal	Suggests matching conversions Example: わ → 和 , 輪 , etc.
E-1-Kana		Lists alphanumerics/katakana assigned to key (🗇 P.3-6)
After a Word is Fixed	Prediction	Suggests words likely to follow Example: 私 is fixed → です , の , は , etc.

• Predictions change with each letter entered.

• Press [Forecast]/[Normal] to toggle Forecast List and Normal List.

Canceling Prediction List

In text entry window, \square [Menu] \rightarrow Input Options \rightarrow Context Prediction \rightarrow OFF

Note

• 831P learns entered characters and suggests them for future conversions.

Example: Enter 私の鼻

- In kanji (hiragana) mode, つ わ is entered and Forecast List appears.
- ∑ to move to Forecast List →∑ to select 私

If the Word is not Listed

 $\mathsf{Press}_{\text{provel}}$ to return to hiragana, and segment hiragana to convert separately.

Example: Segment はるか into はる and か , then convert to 春香

- 1. Move cursor to る , then convert はる to 春 → ullet
- 2. Convert か to 香 → ●

Using Previously Entered Words

Enter the first one or two hiragana to access previously entered words in the list.

Converting Hiragana to Katakana/ Alphanumerics

Enter katakana and alphanumerics in kanji (hiragana) mode. Date and time can be entered quickly. Example 1: Enter OK

Deactivating Learned Words Function

- <Default> ON

- 7 *Learning* → Enter Phone Password
- **3** OFF or OFF in Secret Mode

Deleting Learned Words In Step 2, *Reset Learned Words* → ⊠[YES] → Enter Phone Password

Changing Candidate Font Size

<Default> Normal

- 1 In text entry window, ☐ [Menu] → Input Options
- 2 Candidate Display Size → Select a size

Canceling Prediction List

<Default> ON

- 1 In text entry window, ☑ [Menu] → Input Options
- 2 Prediction Setting → OFF

Fixing Entered Characters Automatically

<Default> OFF

Fix character automatically after specified time elapses.

- Character Set Time → Select a speed

Editing Text

Deleting & Replacing

Delete Characters within Lines

Place cursor before a character → Purst

A character after cursor is deleted.

• Press and hold prove to delete all characters after cursor.

Delete Characters from the End of Text

Place cursor at the end of text \rightarrow Place

A character before cursor is deleted.

• Press and hold with to delete all characters before cursor.

User's Dictionary

Save frequently used words/phrases (up to 100 entries). Saved words/phrases appear among word suggestions.

Saving User's Dictionary Entries

- 1 In text entry window, ⊠[Menu] → *Input Options* → *User's Dictionary*
- 2 **⊠**[Create]*

* When saved items exist: ☑[Menu] → Create

3 Enter a word → Enter reading

Editing User's Dictionary Entries

Highlight a word $\rightarrow \square$ [Menu] \rightarrow Edit \rightarrow Edit word \rightarrow Edit reading

Deleting User's Dictionary Entries

- In text entry window, □ [Menu] → Input Options
 → User's Dictionary
