






Memory Card Check

When Memory Card is installed correctly, ■ appears. If ■ appears, Memory Card cannot be used. Remove Memory Card from handset, and re-insert it. If ■ does not disappear, execute Memory Card Check (⑤P.8-16) or format Memory Card (⑥P.8-15). (Display Indicator: ⑥P.1-8)

Removing

Mail messages, and complete message retrieval is invalidated. Mail Delivery Rule can not be backed up/restored in Incoming Mail. All restored messages from Memory Card are stored to Received folder.	

Calendar	Back up Schedule entries. ◆ Settings such as Reminder, Schedule Tone, Notification Light cannot be backed up/restored. ◆ Schedule entries that cannot be saved on handset ((P.11-3) cannot be restored. ◆ Schedule entries that date/time are not specified cannot be restored.	
Bookmarks	Back up Yahoo! Keitai and PC Site Browser Bookmarks.	
Content Keys	Back up downloaded Content Keys. Content Keys with expiration dates or usage limits cannot be moved to Memory Card. Some applications are made for use on specific models. Notes

- Backup is not available when battery is low. Change/charge battery before backup.
- Backup/restoration activates Emission OFF Mode. When backup/ restoration starts in Emission OFF Mode, Emission OFF Mode is not canceled automatically even when backup/restoration is complete.
- When restoring files other than Content Keys from Memory Card, the same type files are all deleted from handset before restoration. Back up files saved on handset beforehand.



- 831P temporary files are saved in Memory Card PRIVATE MEIGROUP - PMC - FS TEMP folder. All files in this folder are deleted each time Memory Card is inserted into 831P; do not save PC files/folders in this folder.
- Folder layers recognizable in 831P are limited to the first layer of each folder (such as, Music folder) in My Items (MYFOLDER).
- When multiple folders/files with same numbers exist in DCIM folder, the folders/files cannot be viewed on 831P
- Some copy protected files have extensions different from the ones left.
- Images captured by 831P Camera may rotate 90° on cross-carrier handsets or PC.
