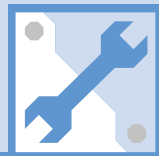

Clock Color	⇒ <b>Clock Display</b> ⇒ ● ⇒ <b>Color</b> ⇒ ● ⇒ <b>Black</b> or <b>White</b> ⇒ ●

## Auto Power On/Off

Set Auto Power On/Off*	<p><b>MENU</b> → <b>Settings</b> → ● → <b>Clock</b> → ● → <b>Auto Power ON</b> or <b>Auto Power OFF</b> → ● → <b>ON</b> → ● → Enter time → ● → <b>1 Time</b> or <b>Daily</b> → ●</p>
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\* When near high precision electronic devices or devices using weak signals, or in areas where handset use is forbidden (aboard aircraft, in hospitals, etc.), set **Auto Power ON** to **OFF** and turn handset power off.

## Display Quality

  - A preview image for each mode appears during selection in *Image Display Mode* to check the effect.

## Backlight

### Set Backlight & Power Saving

- When the Power Saver Mode is activated, nothing appears in Standby. Pressing any key cancels the Power Saver Mode.

Set Brightness of Backlight	<p>⇒ <b>Brightness</b> ⇒ ● ⇒ <b>ON</b> or <b>OFF</b> ⇒ ●</p> <p>⇒ Select a Level ⇒ ●</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When set to <b>ON</b>, Display Backlight automatically adjusts to surrounding brightness; Key Backlight automatically switches on/off.</li> <li>• <b>Brightness</b> is <b>Level 4</b> by default. For maximum brightness, set to <b>Level 6</b>. Note that a higher setting will decrease battery time faster.</li> </ul>
